TOWN OF LINCOLN ANNUAL MEETING APRIL 13, 2010 � 21 persons attended

Dick Thomer, Chairman call the meeting to order at 8:00 pm. He read a brief informational update regarding the annual meeting, SS60.11. The meeting continued on with the following subjects.

1. Financial Report: Judith Johnson presented and explained the 2009 Lincoln Annual Financial Report. The audience discussed the possibility of having the report ready for distribution at the Spring Election in April. This would allow for review and questions at the Annual Meeting. We have made notes to accomplish this for the 2010 report.

2. Dick Thomer reported 2009 Road Work.
a. Roads Repaired: Airport Rd. and Lane, Ranch Road, Bob O Link Drive Blacktopped Airport Rd.
New Culverts
Total Cost \$119,400
b. Crack fill by Fahrner Asphalt Sealers; Total Cost \$9,350
c. Dust Control by Kafka Dust Buster; \$3,553
TOTAL COST FOR ROAD WORK 2009 \$132,300

3. Salt and Sand Roads for 2009: gravel \$13,000 and salt \$2,300 Total Cost \$15,300. This includes some purchased and used in 2010

4. Purchase power washer for use by Fire Dept and Highway Dept.; \$2,000

5. Dick Thomer explained the Prevailing Wage Law Changes as of Jan. 1 2010 that will be in effect for all future contracted work over \$25,000. Wage rates are required for any project of public works erected, constructed, repaired, remodeled, demolished for a local governmental unit. It does not apply to minor projects lasting 5 yrs or less. The Board will be monitoring our projects to make sure all the requirements are being followed.

6. Local Levy and our cash balance 🗞 At this time the local levy cannot be determined. This process is done in the fall.

7. Report on new used truck \$10,300 Andy Gingerich has completed painting the new truck box and the safety lights need to be installed. The Old Truck and box will be put up for bids. We are asking \$2,000 & the ad will be on the web site.

8. Garbage Pickup 🗞 everything seems to be going smoothly. No one had any questions or complaints.

9. House # s s The remainder of the Township will be getting their numbers this summer. The numbers have been ordered.

10. Playground **>** The playground/park has been completed and a fence will be installed for safety purposes blocking out the septic holding tanks and salt/sand pile.

11. Recycling **\diamond** There are no issues here. Dick Thomer has bin available when needed.

12. Fire Dept Report- is there anything they would like to report? There was no report to give � all is going well. The burning ban is still in effect.

13. New voting machine � precinct counter � Training was taken by the clerk and Chief Election Inspectors. The DS200 Counter worked well for us at the April Spring Election.
