Recycling

The recycling board had met on August 20, 2014. The Price is currently at

Road Work 2014:

Brandl's will be replacing culverts on Robin road on September 16, 2014. Crack filling should be done on Airport Road, Falcon Road, Ives Street, Sunset Road, and Eagle Road between H & Y; which could be done in the fall.

Parking on Town Roads:

Hwy operator is unable to plow when people are parking on Cul-de-sac Roads.

Designated no parking areas would have to be done by an ordinance;

specifically describe any no parking areas in the ordinance for it to be off limits; maybe specify times; forfeiture provisions so that in the ordinance everybody understands that if they would get a fine they would know what it is for; proper notice after passage. Citation Authority ordinance which would give who ever we diem the authority to give the citation; would need proper signage, signs would have to placed so when you are standing at one sign you can read the other sign; can write parking tickets and or call and have the vehicle towed at the operators expense would have to be in the ordinance;

Forfeitures cannot be put on the tax bill.
