

TOWN OF LINCOLN
ORDINANCE 1-88

WHEREAS, the Town of Lincoln, by a Town meeting held Tues. April 14, 1987, resolved that the Town Board shall be authorized to exercise powers of a Village Board under Section 60.22 (3) Wisconsin Statutes, pursuant to the authority of Section 60.10 (2) (c) Wisconsin Statutes, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has determined that the public welfare will be served by an increase in the number of supervisors to five (5),

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Lincoln, Wood County, Wisconsin, do hereby ordain as follows:

1. The number of supervisors to be elected to the Town Board of the Town of Lincoln is hereby increased to five (5), including the Town Chairman.
2. There shall be three (3) supervisors, including the Town Chairman, elected on every odd numbered year henceforth.
3. There shall be two (2) supervisors elected each even numbered year henceforth, commencing with the April 1988 election.
4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
