

**RESOLUTION OF TOWN ELECTORS TO ADOPT THE TOTAL TOWN TAX LEVY  
AT SPECIAL TOWN MEETING OF TOWN ELECTORS**

Town of Lincoln, Wood County  
Resolution No. 2022-01

Whereas, Wis. Stat. § 60.10(1)(a) authorizes the town electors of a town to adopt the town tax levy at a town meeting of the electors;

Whereas, a special town meeting of the town electors has been called and properly noticed to approve the 2022 total town tax levy (to be collected in 2023), pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 60.10(1)(a);

**OPTIONAL PARAGRAPH (use only if the electors have approved exceeding the state allowable levy limit either by a town meeting vote or by a referendum vote):**

Whereas, the town electors, after proper notice, have, via a [*special town meeting / referendum*] vote, authorized the Town of Lincoln to exceed the allowable state levy limit;

THEREFORE, the special town meeting of the Town of Lincoln, Wood County, Wisconsin, by a majority vote of the eligible electors duly assembled and voting on this 10<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2022, hereby resolves and orders as follows:

1. **USE ONE OF THE FOLLOWING OPTIONS FOR #1 – EITHER:**  
The town electors of the Town of Lincoln, Wood County, Wisconsin adopt the total town tax levy for 2022 (to be collected in 2023) in the amount of \$ 400,879 [*LLW Section A, Line 10 – insert the total town tax levy to be collected, including any debt service payments and other adjustments taken on the worksheet*].
2. The town clerk shall properly post or publish this resolution as required by law under Wis. Stat. § 60.80(1)(a) within 30 days after its adoption.
